



DID YOU KNOW?

One Barrel of Wine Contains

740 lbs. of grapes
 59 gallons of wine
 24.6 cases of wine
 1,180 glasses of wine

One Case Contains

30 lbs. of grapes
 307.2 oz of wine
 12 bottles of wine
 48 glasses of wine

One Bottle of Wine Contains

2.4 lbs. of grapes
 25.6 oz of wine
 4 glasses of wine

- One acre of vines produces between 4 to 5 tons of grapes.
- A ton of grapes makes about 160 gal. of wine, which makes 800 bottles or 66 cases.
- One vine produces between four to six bottles of wine each year, or 20 to 30 glasses or wine.
- It takes a half-pound of grapes to make a 5-oz glass of wine.
- There are between 15 and 45 clusters of grapes per vine, depending on varietal.
- One acre of land is home to between 800 and 2,000 vines.
- There are approximately 850 wineries in the State of California.
- There are almost 300 wineries in the Napa Valley.
- Only nine percent of Napa County is planted in grapevines.
- Napa wines account for only four percent of California's wine production.
- Napa Valley is 30 miles long and ranges from one to five miles in width.
- In the late 1850's Los Angeles had ten times more vines than Napa.
- California ranks fourth in wine production, following France, Italy, and Spain respectively.

Magnum	2 bottles
Tregnum or tappit-hen	3 bottles
Jeroboam (Champagne)	4 bottles (large bottle, large bowl, engl.slang as per 1950 unabridged Webster dictionary)
Double Magnum	4 bottles
Rehoboam	6 bottles (a very large bowl, bottle container, as per 1950 unabridged Webster dictionary)
Methusaleh (Champagne)	8 bottles (the bigger the bottle the longer quality wine or champagne will be able to age, in the biggest Champagne bottle one assumed wine could reach Methusaleh ages)
Imperiale	8-9 bottles (english measurement)
Salmanazer	Approx. 12 bottles (from Salma, a measure of capacity used in Italy and Sicily, as per unabridged Webster dictionary)
Balthazar	Approx. 16 bottles (King standing for king-size)
Nebuchadnezzar	Approx. 20 bottles (King of Babylon standing for biggest king-size ever made)
