PRODUCTION VOLUMES

(Approximate)

1.0 Ton of Grapes .4 Ton of Grapes

= 2.5 Barrels of Wine = 1 Barrell of Wine
 = 150 Gallons = 60 Gallons
 = 63 Cases = 25 Cases
 = 750 Bottles = 300 Bottles

1 Bottle = 750 ml X 12 - 1 Case = 9.0 L = 2.4 Gallons
